THE Queen, as Sovereign of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, has been graciously pleased, by Letters Patent under Her Royal Sign Manual and the Great Seal of the Order, bearing date this day, to dispense with all the Statutes and Regulations usually observed in regard to Installation, and to grant unto the Most Noble William Henry Walter, Duke of Buccleuch (Knight of the Most Ancient and Most Noble Order of the Thistle), Knight of the said Most Noble Order, and duly invested with the Ensigns thereof, full power and authority to exercise all rights and privileges belonging to a Knight Companion of the said Most Noble Order of the Garter, in as full and ample a manner as if His Grace had been formally installed; any decree, rule, or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.

## THE FAIRS ACT, 1873. THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1894. BELTON FAIR.

THE Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice, that by Memorial, dated the 25th day of November, 1897, a representation has been duly made to him by the Rural District Council of Mutford and Lothingland, that a Fair has been annually held at Belton on Good Friday, and that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that such Fair should in future be held on Easter Monday.

On the 8th day of January, 1898, the Secretary of State will take such representation into consideration, and any person who may desire to object to the alteration of the date for holding the Fair, should intimate his objections to the Secretary of State before that day.
