PARTICULARS OF PIECEWORK WAGES (WHOLESALE TAILORING).

IN pursuance of section 1 of "The Rules Publication Act, 1893," notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Home Department proposes, at the expiration of forty days from the publication of this notice, to make an order under section 40 of "The Factory and Workshop Act, 1895," extending the provisions of that section, with modifications, to the classes of factories and workshops in which wholesale tailoring is carried on.

ORDER of the Local Government Board: District Auditor: Assignment of District and Duties (Supplemental):—

Mid-Lancashire Audit District.

Port of Preston.

To Arthur Carson Roberts, District Auditor;—
To the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Preston, acting by the Council, being the Port Sanitary Authority for part of the Customs Port of Preston, and hereinafter termed the "Preston Port Sanitary Authority";—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of "The District Auditors Act, 1879," it is enacted that the Local Government Board may from time to time assign to District Auditors their Duties, and the Districts in which such Auditors respectively are to act, and may from time to time change wholly or in part such Duties or Districts;

And whereas by an Order dated the 29th day of March, 1894, We, the Local Government Board, certified the appointment of the said Arthur Carson Roberts as a District Auditor, and ordered that the District in which he should act as Auditor, and which should be termed "The Mid-Lancashire Audit District," should, for the

performance of the duties assigned to him by Article I of the Order, comprise the area for the time being included in the several Unions named in the Schedule to that Order, and in the Districts mentioned in paragraphs (3) and (4) of the said Article I and the Districts or areas referred to in paragraph (6) of such Article;

And whereas it is prescribed by the said Article I that it shall be the duty of the said District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the Authorities and their Officers mentioned or referred to in Nos. (1), (2), (3), (4), and (5) of that Article, as well as the Accounts of such of the other Authorities whose Accounts are or may be by law subject to be audited by a District Auditor, and whose Districts or the areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time being partly situated within one or more of the said Unions, as We might by Order under Seal thereafter prescribe;

And whereas by an Order dated the 2nd day of February, 1898, We directed that it should be the duty of the said Arthur Carson Roberts to audit the Accounts of the Hospital Committee mentioned in such Order, and of their Officers;

And whereas the Preston Port Sanitary Authority is an Authority whose Accounts are subject to be audited by a District Auditor, and the District of the said Port Sanitary Authority is partly situated within one or more of the said Unions;

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, We hereby Order and Prescribe that it shall, until We otherwise prescribe, be the duty of the said Arthur Carson Roberts to audit the Accounts of the Preston Port Sanitary Authority, and of their Officers, in conformity with the provisions contained in the above-cited Order; and that for the purpose of such Audit the District of the said Port Sanitary Authority shall be deemed to be within the said Mid-Lancashire Audit District.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

COW-SHEDS PLEURO-PNEUMONIA REVOCATION ORDER OF 1898.

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The Order described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby from and after the commencement of this Order revoked: Provided that such revocation shall not invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the Order hereby revoked, or affect any licence or authority granted, or any right, title, obligation, or liability accrued thereunder before the commencement of this Order, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any
