

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant to the respective Incumbents for the time being of the benefices situate within the original limits of the parish of Manchester, in the county of Lancaster, and in the diocese of Manchester, which are named in the schedule hereunto annexed, the several sums the amounts of which are set opposite to the names of the said benefices respectively in the second column of the same schedule, the said sums to be payable out of the common fund under our control, for and in respect of the year ending the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, in equal moieties, one such moiety to be receivable on the first day of November now next ensuing, and the other on the first day of May following.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Winwick

Rectory Act, 1884, do hereby, subject as herein-after mentioned, grant to the respective Incumbents of the benefices severally named in the schedule hereto, and situate in the county of Lancaster, and in the diocese of Liverpool, and to their successors, Incumbents of the same, the yearly sums or stipends set opposite to the names of the said benefices, respectively, in the last column of the said schedule, such yearly sums or stipends to be payable out of the annual income of the Winwick Rectory Trust Fund, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, and to be calculated as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight, and to be receivable in equal half-yearly portions on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always that the yearly sums hereby granted are, in case of deficiency of income of the Winwick Rectory Trust Fund, subject to abatement, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act.
