

time when required by the Guardians to do so, examine the stock of drugs, medicines, medical and surgical appliances, and medical stores in the dispensaries at the workhouses and infirmary, and at the out-door dispensaries provided for the said Union, and shall compare the same with the account kept by the dispenser for such dispensaries, showing the receipt and consumption or disposal of the stock committed to his charge.

He shall also on the day next after the termination of each quarter, and at any other time when required by the Guardians to do so, examine the stock of provisions and stores in the charge of each of the Out-Door Relief (in kind) Distributors, and shall compare the same with the Accounts required to be kept by those officers respectively.

(2.) The following shall be substituted for Articles VII, VIII, and IX:—

ARTICLE VII.—The Masters and Dispensers of the Workhouses, the Steward and the Dispenser of the Infirmary, the Dispensers of the Out-Door Dispensaries, the Out-Door Relief (in kind) Distributors, and the Superintendent of the Cottage Homes shall, when required by the Stocktaker to do so, on the days and at the times referred to in Article V, submit to him the stores and Accounts therein mentioned, and render to him such assistance as may be necessary for the purpose of such examination and comparison as aforesaid.

ARTICLE VIII.—The Masters and Dispensers of the Workhouses, the Steward and the Dispenser of the Infirmary, the Dispensers of the Out-Door Dispensaries, the Out-Door Relief (in kind) Distributors, and the Superintendent of the Cottage Homes shall lay each of the said Accounts before the Guardians at their next meeting after the date of the entry therein of any such certificate as aforesaid.

ARTICLE IX.—So long as a Stocktaker is appointed it shall not be necessary for the Visiting Committees to examine the stores or to enter in any Account the memorandum required by the above-cited Orders dated the fourteenth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, the eighth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four, the sixth day of August, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four, and the sixth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine.
