ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

(DATED 1ST SEPTEMBER 1898.)

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Application of Swine-Fever (Movement) Order of 1898.

1. From and after the commencement of this Order the District of the Local Authority mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be subject to the Swine-Fever (Movement) Order of 1898 and the provisions of such Order shall apply thereto accordingly:

Provided that any part of the said District which for the time being is declared by Special Order of the Board of Agriculture to be a Swine-Fever-Infected Area shall not be subject to the Swine-Fever (Movement) Order of 1898.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the sixth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-eight.
