

wode; Hillesdon and Addington, in the Rural District of Buckingham; the Parishes of Hoggeston and Dunton in the Rural District of Winslow; the Parishes of Creslow, Aston Abbots and Drayton Beauchamp in the Rural District of Aylesbury; and the Parish of Slapton in the Rural District of Wing;

In the County of Hertford.—The Parishes of Little Gaddesden, Great Gaddesden, Hemel Hempstead, Abbots Langley, Kings Langley, Tring, Shenley, Ridge, Aldenham and Elstree; the Parish of Tring Rural in the Rural District of Berkhamstead; the Parishes of Saint Michael Rural, Saint Peter Rural, and Saint Stephen in the Rural District of Saint Albans; and the Parish and Urban District of Tring.

Work No. 3.—An Aqueduct Conduit or Line of Pipes (No. 3) commencing in the Parish of Elstree in the County of Herts at the southern embankment of the proposed Borehamwood Reservoir at a point on the present site of Shenley Road 60 chains or thereabouts from the junction therewith at Borehamwood of the road leading from Borehamwood to Radlett and 15 chains or thereabouts west from Thrift Farm and terminating in the Parish of Edgware in the County of Middlesex at the lands for filter beds hereinafter described at a point 15 chains or thereabouts southward from the eastern corner of Scratch Wood;

Work No. 4.—An Aqueduct Conduit or Line of Pipes situate in the Parish of Edgware and in the Parish and Urban District of Hendon in the County of Middlesex commencing in the Parish of Edgware at the point of termination of the herein described Work No. 3 and terminating in the Parish or Urban District of Hendon at a point in the road called Selvage Lane 4 chains or thereabouts east of the centre of the bridge carrying that road over the Midland Railway;

Work No. 5.—A new Road or Road Diversion situate in the Parish of Aldenham in the County of Herts commencing at a point in the road leading from Borehamwood to Radlett about 18 chains measured along that road in a north-westerly direction from the junction of the said road with the Shenley Road at Borehamwood and terminating at a point in the said road leading from Borehamwood to Radlett 23 chains or thereabouts measured along that road from Theobald Street Farm;

Work No. 6.—A new Road or Road Diversion situate in the Parish of Elstree in the County of Herts commencing at a point in the Shenley Road 30 chains or thereabouts measured in a

north-easterly direction along the said road from the junction therewith at Borehamwood of the road from Borehamwood to Radlett and terminating at a point in the said Shenley Road 10 chains or thereabouts north-west from Thrift Farm;

Land for Filter Beds.—To empower the Council to purchase and take certain Lands in the Parish of Edgware and Parish and Urban district of Hendon in the County of Middlesex adjoining the Midland Railway and bounded as follows:—On the south-west by the Midland Railway between the southern face of Borehamwood Tunnel and the bridge carrying Selvage Lane over the said Railway at a point about 50 chains north-westward from the Mill Hill Station; on the south and east by the said Selvage Lane to its junction with Marsh Lane, and from the said junction by Hankins Lane to its termination at a point 18 chains or thereabouts northward of Coventry Farm; thence by an imaginary line drawn 20 chains or thereabouts northward of the northern end of Hankins Lane thence to the eastern corner of Scratch Wood and thence to the southern face of the said tunnel;

To empower the Council to deviate from the lines and levels of the intended Works as shown on the Plans and Sections thereof to be deposited as hereinafter mentioned to any extent which may be prescribed in or authorised by the intended Act.

To empower the Council for the purposes of the intended Act to purchase or acquire by compulsion or agreement or to take on lease any lands houses or buildings in the several Counties Parishes and places aforesaid delineated on the deposited Plans and described in the deposited Books of Reference and to acquire by compulsion or agreement rights or easements in over or connected with any such lands houses and buildings.

To enable the Council to purchase so much only of any property as may be required for the purposes of the intended Act and to exempt the Council from the liability imposed by the 92nd Section of the Lands Clauses Consolidation Act 1845.

To make provision as to payment of costs in certain cases of disputed compensation by persons claiming compensation from the Council.

It is proposed to take for and in connection with the intended Works and other the purposes of the intended Act certain lands being or reputed to be common or commonable lands of which the following are the particulars:—
