numbered 469 on the Ordnance Map $\frac{1}{2500}$ Radnorshire Sheet VII. 16 at a point 14 chains or thereabouts measured in a south-westerly direction from a milestone on the Rhayader and Llangurig road denoting 4 miles from Rhayader and terminate in the Parish of Saint Harmon in a field or enclosure numbered 830 on the before-mentioned Ordnance Map Radnorshire Sheet VII. 16, 2 chains or thereabouts northeast from the said milestone.

Work No. 17.—A railway situate in the Parish of Saint Harmon in the County of Radnor commencing by a junction with the Mid-Wales section of the Cambrian Railway at a point coinciding with the south-western face of the Marteg tunnel about 10 miles from Llanidloes and terminating at the point hereinbefore described as the termination of the dam or embankment of the Upper Wye Reservoir.

Work No. 18.—An aqueduct conduit or line of pipes situate in the Parish of Llansantfraid-Cwmdeuddwr and Saint Harmon in the County of Radnor and in the Parishes of Llansfanfawr, Llanshangel-Bryn-Pabuan, Llysdinam, and Llanwrthwl in the County of Brecknock and commencing in the Parish of Llansantffraid-Cwmdeuddwr at the southern end of the Upper Wye Reservoir (Work No. 13) hereinbefore described on the River Wye in the field or enclosure numbered 468 on the Ordnance Map 2700 Radnorshire Sheet VII. 16 at a point No. 27025.

Work No. 20.—An aqueduct conduit or line of pipes situate in the said parishes of Llanafan-fechan Llanganten Llanafan-fawr and Llanfihangel-Bryn-Pabuan in the County of Brecknock commencing at the Llanafan Reservoir in the Parish of Llanafan-fawr at a point in the Chwefri stream about 19 chains measured in a north-easterly direction from the Church of Saint Afan and about 17 chains measured in a south-easterly direction from the house called Rhiw-oleu on the Ordnance Map 1 2 500 Breck-nockshire Sheet VIII. 9 and terminating in the Parish of Llanganten at a point in the Yrfon Reservoir at the site of a stream or watercourse chains or thereabouts measured in a southerly direction from Careg-y-ffynnon farmhouse and near the junction of the enclosures numbered 217 and 197 on the Ordnance Map ¹/₂₅₀₀ Brecknockshire Sheet XI. 2.

To empower the Council to deviate from the lines and levels of the intended Works as shown on the Plans and Sections thereof to be deposited as hereinafter mentioned to any extent which may be prescribed or referred to in the intended Act.

To empower the Council to take collect divert impound and use, for the purpose of the supply of Water, the waters of the Rivers Yrfon Cliwefri Wye and Towy and all the tributary streams and springs of the said rivers at and above the points hereafter described viz.:—

(a) The Yrfon and all tributary streams thereof above the point where the dam or embankment hereinbefore described as intended to form the Yrfon Reservoir will cross the River Yrfon;

(b) The Wye and all tributary streams thereof above the point where the dam or embankment hereinbefore described as
