Le Four Light-Experimental Alteration.

THE French Government has given notice, dated 31st May, 1899, that the duration of each of the flashes of the fixed and flashing light of le Four will be experimentally reduced to half a second, and their power increased to 3,500 becs Carcel (= 35,000 candle power); the power of the fixed light will also be increased to 800 becs Carcel (= 8,000 candle power). In other respects the light will remain unaltered.
