No. 338.—FRANCE—WEST COAST.

Le Four Light—Experimental Alteration.

THE French Government has given notice,
dated 31st May, 1899, that the duration of each
of the flashes of the fixed and flashing light of
le Four will be experimentally reduced to half a
second, and their power increased to 3,500 becs
Carcel (= 35,000 candle power); the power of
the fixed light will also be increased to 800 becs
Carcel (= 8,000 candle power). In other respects
the light will remain unaltered.

No. 339.—CHILE—CONCHALI BAY.

Corales or Penitente Rock—Height.

INFORMATION, dated 17th April, 1899,
has been received from the Superintendent of the
Gulf Line of steamships, Valparaiso, that Corales
or Penitente Rock, Conchalí Bay, which is re-
presented on the Chart as awash at low water,
is in reality about 20 feet above high water; the
Chart has consequently been amended to agree
with this statement.
