ORDERS for the Court's going into Mourning on Thursday next, the 13th instant, for His late Imperial Highness The Grand Duke Césarévitch, George Alexandrovitch, Brother and Heir-Presumptive to His Majesty The Emperor of All the Russias, viz. :—

The Ladies to wear black Dresses, white Gloves, black or white Shoes, Feathers, and Fans, Pearls, Diamonds, or plain gold or silver Ornaments.

The Gentlemen to wear black Court Dress, with black Swords and Buckles.

The Court to change the Mourning on Thursday, the 20th instant, viz. :—

The Ladies to wear black Dresses, with coloured Ribbons, Flowers, Feathers, and Ornaments, or grey or white Dresses, with black Ribbons, Flowers, Feathers, and Ornaments.

The Gentlemen to continue the same Mourning.

And on Sunday, the 23rd instant, the Court to go out of Mourning.
