Drills performed in first year by recruits, beyond the thirty required for efficiency, may be counted towards the second year's efficiency, but a minimum of twelve gun drills, including the Inspection, must be performed in the second year, and of the sixty drills in the first two years forty must be gun drills.

Two gun drills in addition must be performed in all cases where Volunteers joined after the Inspection, or were absent from the Inspection with leave of the Commanding Officer, or through sickness duly certified.

In all cases attendance at the Inspection may be reckoned as a gun drill, and attendance at a review may be counted as a drill.

No gun drill will count unless at least four Volunteers attend.

CERTIFICATE.

1. That A B No. was duly enrolled in the Muster Roll of the Volunteer Artillery Corps on the one thousand eight hundred and , and is actually a member of the Corps on this date.

Four parades required by paragraph five hundred and ninety, Volunteer Regulations, to count ... 12 drills.

Four mounted drills (each drill to be of not less than two hours' duration with at least two guns with their teams available for instruction), to count as ... 8 "

(If the number of recruits are insufficient for two teams one team only will be required.)
