WILD BIRD (ENGLAND).

The Wild Birds Protection (County of Rutland) Order, 1899.

Dated 25th August, 1899.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Wild Birds Protection Acts, 1880 to 1895, and upon application by the County Council of the Administrative County of Rutland, I hereby make the following Order:—

I. This Order may be cited as "The Wild Birds Protection (County of Rutland) Order, 1899."

BIRDS.

Additions to the Schedule of the Act of 1880.

II. "The Wild Birds Protection Act, 1880," shall apply within the County of Rutland to the following species of Wild Birds in the same manner as if those species were included in the Schedule to the Act:—

Buntings (Black-headed Bunting, Corn Bunting, Cirl Bunting, Reed Bunting), Chats (Whinchat, Stonechat), Chiffchaff, Dipper, Flycatchers, Hawks (Common Buzzard, Honey Buzzard, Kestrel, Merlin, Hobby, Osprey), Hedge Sparrow, Heron, Linnet, Martins (House Martin, Sand Martin), Nuthatch, Pipits, Redstart, Robin, Shrikes, Siskin, Swallow, Swift, Tits (Long-tailed Tit, Great Tit, Coal Tit, Marsh Tit, Bearded Tit), Treecreeper, Wagtails (White Wagtail, Pied Wagtail, Grey Wagtail, Yellow Wagtail), Warblers (Garden Warbler, Sedge Warbler, Dartford Warbler, Reed Warbler, Grasshopper Warbler, Willow Warbler, Wood Warbler), Wheatear, Whitethroat, Widgeon, Woodcock, Woodpeckers (all species), Wrens (all species), Wryneck (Cuckoo's Mate or Snake Bird).

EGGS.

Certain Eggs protected throughout the County.

III. The taking or destroying of the Eggs of the following species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout the County of Rutland:—

Bee-eater, Bittern, Bullfinch, Buntings (Corn Bunting, Reed Bunting), Chats (Whinchat,

Stonechat), Chiffchaff, Dipper, Flycatchers (Pied and Spotted), Goldfinch, Grebe (Lesser (Dabchick) Grebe, Great Crested Grebe), Hawfinch, Hawks (Common Buzzard, Honey Buzzard, Kestrel, Merlin, Hobby, Osprey), Hedge Sparrow, Heron, Hoopoe, Kingfisher, Linnet, Martins (House Martin, Sand Martin), Nightingale, Nightjar (Goatsucker, Night Hawk, or Fern Owl), Nuthatch, Oriole, Owls (Brown Owl, Long-eared Owl, Short-eared Owl, White Owl (or Barn Owl)), Pipits (Meadow Pipit, Rock Pipit, Tree Pipit), Pochard, Redstart, Sandpiper (Summersnipe), Shelldrake, Shoveller, Shrikes (Butcher Birds), Swallow, Siskin, Snipe, Stock Dove, Teal, Tits (Cole Tit, Marsh Tit), Treecreeper, Wagtails (Grey Wagtail, Grey-headed Wagtail, Pied Wagtail, Yellow Wagtail), Warblers (Garden Warbler, Sedge Warbler, Dartford Warbler, Reed Warbler, Grasshopper Warbler, Willow Warbler, Wood Warbler), Wheatear, Whitethroat, Widgeon, Woodcock, Woodpeckers (all species), Wrens (all species), Wryneck (Cuckoo's Mate or Snake Bird).

IV. The Order of the 14th May, 1897, is hereby repealed.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

(DATED 31ST AUGUST 1899.)

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1895, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:
