And whereas it is expedient that further provision in the matter should be made as herein-after mentioned:

Now therefore, we, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, hereby Order and Direct as follows with respect to each of the aforesaid Unions:—

GENERAL ORDER of the Local Government Board: Guardians' Order upon Treasurer:—
Bala, Corwen, and Dolgelly Unions.
To the Guardians of the Poor of the Bala, Corwen, and Dolgelly Unions;—
To the Treasurers of the said Guardians;—
And to all others whom it may concern.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the said General Order dated the seventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, the Guardians of the Poor of each of the said Unions may, if they think fit, pay any sum by an order drawn upon their Treasurer in the Form contained in the Schedule hereto, which order shall be signed by the presiding Chairman and two other Guardians at a meeting, and shall be countersigned by the Clerk to the Guardians.

WHEREAS by a General Order dated the 7th day of April, 1857, addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of the Bala, Corwen, and Dolgelly Unions, amongst others, the Poor Law Board directed that all orders which might be drawn by such Guardians of the Poor upon their respective Treasurers for a sum greater than five pounds should, from and after the 24th day of June, 1857, be in the form prescribed by the said General Order;

And We do hereby Order the Treasurer of the Guardians to pay, out of the moneys for the time being in his hands belonging to them, all orders for money which shall be drawn upon him in the said Form contained in the Schedule to this Order, when the same shall be presented at his house or usual place of business, and within the usual hours of business.
