

of their capital or funds, from time to time, interest or dividends on shares or stock of the Company.

To vary and extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with any of the objects of the intended Act, and to confer other rights and privileges.

To incorporate with the Bill, among other Acts, and to extend to the Company and to the deviation railway, new railways and subways proposed to be constructed, all or any of the provisions of the Companies Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, the Companies Clauses Act, 1863, and the Companies Clauses Act, 1869, the Lands Clauses Acts, the Railways Clauses Consolidation Act, 1845, and the Railways Clauses Act, 1863, with such alterations and amendments as may be deemed expedient, and to enable the Company to exercise the powers or any of the powers contained in those Acts.

Llandrindod Wells Water.

(Construction of New Works; Compulsory Purchase of Lands; Extension of Limits of Supply; Power to Levy Rents, Rates, and Charges; Additional Capital and Application of Funds; Amendment of Acts; Agreements with Local Authorities, &c.)

NOTICE is hereby given; that application is intended to be made to Parliament in the ensuing Session by the Llandrindod Wells Water Company (hereinafter called "the Company") for an Act for all or some of the following and/or other purposes:—

To authorise the Company to make and maintain the works hereinafter described, or some or one of them, with all necessary dams, weirs, washouts, embankments, tanks, sluices, culverts, pipes, conduits, channels, overflows, manholes, outfalls, valves, stand pipes, wells, pumps, drains, filter beds, engines, telegraphic and other electric communication, and other conveniences and appliances connected with or auxiliary to the intended works respectively (that is to say):—

1. A storage reservoir to be formed by means of a wall or embankment at or near a farm known as Nursery Cottage, in the parish of Cefnlllys, to be called the Nursery Reservoir.

2. A high service tank in the Cwmyrain Dingle, in the parish of Llandrindod, to be formed by means of a retaining wall.

3. A collecting tank to be formed by means of a wall or embankment and a dam across the brook at or near Ffrwd's Farm in the parish of Cefnlllys.

4. An aqueduct (No. 1), conduit, or line of pipes commencing at the proposed Nursery Reservoir in the parish of Cefnlllys, and terminating at the existing main of the Company at or near the Pump House Hotel in the parish of Llandrindod.

5. An aqueduct (No. 2), conduit, or line of pipes commencing at Ffrwd Springs, in the parish of Cefnlllys, and terminating by a junction with the before mentioned aqueduct No. 1 at a point midway between the Cwmbrith and the upper Cwmbrith Farmsteads.

6. An aqueduct (No. 3), conduit, or line of pipes commencing at or near Wern-ddu Barn in the parish of Llandrindod, and terminating in the parish of Cefnlllys, at or near the existing Llanfawr service reservoir of the Company.

7. A collecting tank, pumping station, and receiving tank situated upon the Cwmbrith Bank, in the parish of Cefnlllys, and a conduit or line of pipes connecting such collecting tank and pumping station with the receiving tank.

8. A collecting tank and pumping station situate at a point midway or thereabouts between Trawsty and Rhewl Farmsteads, in the parish of Cefnlllys.

9. A new road commencing at a point on the existing road from Penybont to Rhewl, passing through numbers 162 and 158 on the 25-inch Ordnance sheet of the parish of Cefnlllys, and terminating at a junction with the road between Rhewl and Trawsty.
