If he find the stock to be in any respect incorrect, he shall make such alteration in the said certificate as he may deem necessary, specifying the particulars in which he finds the quantities of stock to be incorrectly stated.

ARTICLE VI.—The Master of the Workhouse shall, when required by the Stocktaker, to do so, on the days and at the times referred to in Article IV, submit to him the stores and Accounts therein mentioned, and render to him such assistance as may be necessary for the purpose of such examination and comparison as aforesaid.

ARTICLE VII.—The Master of the Workhouse shall lay each of the said Accounts before the Guardians at their next meeting after the date of the entry therein of any such certificate as aforesaid.

ARTICLE VIII.—So long as a Stocktaker is appointed it shall not be necessary for the Visiting Committee to examine the stores or to enter in any Account the memorandum required by the first above-cited Order.

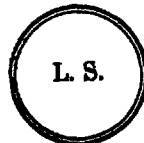
THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The Order described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby from and after the commencement of this Order revoked: Provided that such revocation shall not invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the Order hereby revoked before the commencement of this Order, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the Order hereby revoked before the commencement of this Order.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twelfth day of February, one thousand nine hundred.

(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE.)

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF  
AGRICULTURE.

(DATED 7TH FEBRUARY 1900.)

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

*Movement for Slaughter into Boroughs of Lowestoft, Norwich, and Yarmouth.*

1. Notwithstanding anything in the Order described in the Schedule hereto an animal may be moved into the borough of Lowestoft, the borough

of Norwich, or the borough of Yarmouth from any place outside the District defined by the said Order, provided that the animal is so moved without being untrucked within the said District; and an animal so moved into a borough may be moved from the railway premises by the nearest available route to a slaughter-house within the borough, and shall be there detained and be slaughtered within four days from the date of its arrival in the borough.

*Movement of Animals on a highway between different parts of a Farm in the same Occupation.*

2. Notwithstanding anything in the said Order an animal may be moved by the nearest available route along or across a highway or thoroughfare in the District defined by the said Order from one
