

**ORDER of the Local Government Board:**  
District Auditor: Assignment of District and Duties (County Councils):—

South-Western Counties Audit District.

To Charles Hunton, District Auditor;—

To the County Councils of the several Administrative Counties named in the Schedule to this Order;—

To the Visiting Committees of any Lunatic Asylums belonging wholly or in part to one or more of the said County Councils and not belonging in part to any other County Council;—

To the Council of the Isles of Scilly, and to the Overseers of the Poor of the Parishes of Bryher, Saint Agnes, Saint Martin's, Saint Mary's, and Tresco, which are included in the said Isles;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of the District Auditors Act, 1879, it is enacted that the Local Government Board may from time to time assign to District Auditors their Duties, and the Districts in which such Auditors respectively are to act, and may from time to time change wholly or in part such Duties or Districts;

And whereas by an Order dated the 16th day of June, 1897, We, the Local Government Board, certified the appointment of the said Charles Hunton as a District Auditor, and directed that, unless We otherwise prescribed, it should be the duty of the said District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the County Councils of the several Administrative Counties named in Schedule A to that Order (such Counties being those named in the Schedule to this Order) and the other Accounts referred to in Article I of such Order, including the Accounts of the Council of the Isles of Scilly, and of the Overseers of the Poor of the Parishes of Bryher, Saint Agnes, Saint Martin's, Saint Mary's, and Tresco, which are included in the said Isles, so far as the same might relate to any period prior to the 1st day of April, 1897; and We further directed that the District in which the said Charles Hunton should act as Auditor, and which should be termed the "South-Western Counties Audit District," should, for the performance of the duties assigned to him by Article I of the said Order, comprise the area for the time being included in the several Administrative Counties named in the said Schedule A and in the Isles of Scilly;

And whereas by Orders dated respectively the 16th day of March, 1898, and the 24th day of January, 1899, We altered the said Order dated the 16th day of June, 1897, as therein mentioned, the effect of such alterations being the substitution in Article I of that Order of the words "first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine," for the words "first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven";

And whereas it is expedient that the said Order should be further altered as hereinafter mentioned:

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us in that behalf, We hereby alter the said Order dated the sixteenth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven (as altered as aforesaid), by the substitution in Article I thereof of the words "first day of April, one thousand nine hundred," for the words "first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine"; and We do hereby Order that the said Order as so altered shall have full force and effect as if the words hereby substituted therein had been originally contained in such Order.

**ORDER of the Local Government Board:**  
District Auditor: Assignment of District and Duties (County Councils):—

South-Eastern Counties Audit District.

To Lawrance Hargreaves Wraith, District Auditor;—

To the County Councils of the several Administrative Counties named in the Schedule to this Order, and to the County Council of the Administrative County of Dorset;—

To the Visiting Committees of any Lunatic Asylums belonging wholly or in part to one or more of the said County Councils and not belonging in part to any other County Council;—

To the Local Sea Fisheries Committee for the Southern Sea Fisheries District;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of the District Auditors Act, 1879, it is enacted that the Local Government Board may from time to time assign to District Auditors their Duties, and the Districts in which such Auditors respectively are to act, and may from time to time change wholly or in part such Duties or Districts;

And whereas by an Order dated the 16th day of June, 1897, We, the Local Government Board, certified the appointment of the said Lawrance Hargreaves Wraith as a District Auditor, and directed that, unless We otherwise prescribed, it should be the duty of the said District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the County Councils of the several Administrative Counties named in Schedule A to that Order (such Counties being those named in the Schedule to this Order), except the Council of the Administrative County of Southampton and the other Accounts referred to in Article I of such Order, so far as the same might relate to any period prior to the 1st day of April, 1897; and We further directed that the District in which the said Lawrance Hargreaves Wraith should act as Auditor, and which should be termed the "South-Eastern Counties Audit District," should, for the performance of the duties assigned to him by Article I of the said Order, comprise the area for the time being included in the several Administrative Counties named in the said Schedule and the area comprised in the Southern Sea Fisheries District;
