A bell buoy painted red, and situate half a mile W.S.W. from the end of the South Breakwater marks the seaward limit of the said harbour.

Every licensed pilot who may be employed to pilot any ship or vessel into the Port of Port Talbot from any of the places named in the following Schedule or vice versa shall receive in addition to the before-mentioned Port Pilotage, the following Channel Pilotage:
