ARTICLE VIII. Subject to the foregoing regulations and the Regulations of the Commissioners in Lunacy above referred to, every patient received

into the said Workhouse shall be amenable to the Regulations in force respecting the government of the said Workhouse.

ARTICLE IX. Expressions in this Order shall have the same meaning as in the Lunacy Act, 1890.
