ORDER OF THE BOARD OF

(DATED 2ND MAY 1900.)

(SWINE-FEVER INFECTED AREA.)

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an area infected with swine-fever for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Infected Areas) Order of 1896.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the ninth day of May, one thousand nine hundred.

NORFOLK AND SUFFOLK MOVEMENT (FOOT-AND-
MOUTH DISEASE) ORDER OF 1900.

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Alteration of Boundaries of Scheduled District.

1. The provisions of an Order dated the 24th day of April last, prohibiting the movement of cattle, sheep, goats or swine into, or out of, or along a highway or thoroughfare within, a District therein mentioned shall, after the commencement of this Order, apply only to the District described in the Schedule to this Order, and shall be subject to the following Article of this Order.

Movement within Scheduled District.

2.—(1) An animal may be moved from any premises in the said District to any other premises within such District provided that the animal is accompanied by a Movement Licence as required by this Article.

(2) The Licence shall only be granted on a Declaration of the owner of the animal or of his agent authorized in writing for this purpose to the effect:

(i.) that the animal to be moved has been on the premises from which it is to be moved for a period of at least twenty-eight days immediately before the granting of the Licence, and that no other cattle, sheep, goats, or swine have been brought on to those premises within such period; and

(ii.) that the animal is not affected with Foot-and-Mouth Disease and has not during the preceding twenty-eight days been in any way exposed to the infection of such disease; and

(iii.) that the movement of the animal is not prohibited by Notice of an Inspector of the Local Authority or of the Board of Agriculture given under any Order of the Board; and every such Declaration shall be annexed to the Licence granted thereon.

(3) No Licence shall be granted for movement from or to premises in a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Place.

(4) The Licence may be granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the place from which the animal is to be moved.

(5) The Licence shall be in force for not more than four days, inclusive of the day of issue, and shall specify the name and address of the person to whom the Licence is granted, the number and description of the animals to be moved, and the name or description of the place or premises from which and the place or premises to which the animals are to be moved.

(6) Every animal shall be moved by the nearest available route and be accompanied by the Licence.

Saving for Orders and Regulations.

3. Movement of animals under this Order is subject to any Order of the Board relating to any Disease other than Foot-and-Mouth Disease, and also subject to any Regulation made by a Local Authority under any Order of the Board for prohibiting or regulating the movement of animals, but nothing in any such Regulation shall permit the movement of animals in contravention of this Order.

Production of Licences; Names and Addresses.

4.—(1.) Any person in charge of an animal being moved, where under this Order a Movement Licence is necessary, shall, on demand of a Justice, or of a constable, or of an Inspector or other officer of the Board of Agriculture or of a Local Authority, produce and show to him the Licence, if any, necessary for the movement, and shall allow it to be read and a copy of or extract from it to be taken by the person to whom it is produced.

(2.) Any person so in charge shall, on demand as aforesaid, give his name and address to the Justice, or constable, or Inspector or other officer.

Offences.

5.—(1.) If any head of cattle, sheep, goat or pig is moved into or out of the said District, or is moved along a highway or thoroughfare within such District otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of this Order, the owner of the animal, and the person for the time being in charge thereof, and the person causing,
