SWINE-FEVER INFECTED AREAS.

THE following Areas are now Areas Injected with Swine-Fever under the above-mentioned Acts :--

Bedfordshire.—(1.) An Area comprising the petty sessional divisions of Leighton Buzzard and Luton, and the borough of Dunstable, in the administrative county of Bedford; and also comprising the borough of Luton (21 May, 1900).

(2.) An Area comprising the parishes of Old Warden, Southill, Biggleswade, Dunton, Edworth, Astwick, Stotfold, Arlesey, Langford, Henlow, Upper Stondon, Meppershall, Clifton, Shefford, Shefford Hardwick, Campton, and Chicksands Priory, in the administrative county of Bedford (5 July, 1900).

Cheshire.—(1.) An Area comprising the parishes of Liscard, Poulton-cum-Seacomb, Wallasey, Bidston-cum-Ford, and Noctorum, in the administrative county of Chester; and also comprising the borough of Birkenhead (9 May, 1900).

(2.) An Area comprising the petty sessional divisions of Chester Castle, Eddisbury, Broxton, Nantwich, and Middlewich and Sandbach, in the administrative county of Chester; and also comprising the boroughs of Chester, Crewe, and Congleton (4 July, 1900).

- Derbyshire.—An Area comprising the parishes of Whittington, Staveley, Brimington, Tapton, and Newbold and Dunston, in the administrative county of Derby; and also comprising the borough of Chesterfield (2 May, 1900).
- Devonshire.—An Area comprising the parishes of Lympston, Withycombe Baleigh, East Budleigh, Budleigh Salterton, and Littleham, in the administrative county of Devon (21 May, 1900).
- Dorsetshire.—An Area comprising the parishes of Broadway, Radipole, Chickerell, Fleet, and

Wyke Regis, in the administrative county of Dorset, and also comprising the borough of Weymouth and Melcombe Regis (14 July, 1900).

- Flintshire.—An Area comprising the petty sessional divisions of Hawarden (except the detached portion) and Hope, in the administrative county of Flint (26 May, 1900).
- Gloucestershire.—(1.) An Area comprising the petty sessional divisions of Tewkesbury (except the parishes of Twyning and Forthampton), Gloucester, Stroud, Whitminster, Horsley, Dursley, and Berkeley, and the borough of Tewkesbury, in the administrative county of Gloucester; and also comprising the borough of Gloucester (23 May, 1900).

(2.) An Area comprising the petty sessional divisions of Lawford's Gate and Sodbury, in the administrative county of Gloucester (6 July, 1900).

- Hampshire and Sussex.—An Area comprising the petty sessional divisions of Chichester and Arundel, the detached portions of the petty sessional division of Worthing, and the borough of Chichester, in the administrative county of West Sussex; and also comprising the petty sessional divisions of Fareham (except the parishes of Wickham, Boarhunt, Fareham, Titchfield, Hook-with-Warsach, Sarisbury, Crofton, Rowner, and Alverstoke), and the parishes of Hambledon, Catherington, Clanfield, Chalton, Blendworth, and Idsworth, in the administrative county of Southampton; and also comprising the borough of Portsmouth (28 June, 1900).
- Lancashire.—An Area comprising the petty sessional divisions of Wigan (except the parish of Haigh), Leigh, Warrington, St. Helens, Childwall, Prescot, Kirkdale (except the parish of Garston), Ormskirk, Southport, Kirkham, and Amounderness, and the parishes of Inskipwith-Sowerby, Myerscough, and Bilsborrow, in
