## ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

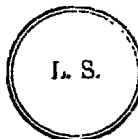

interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the Order hereby revoked before the date of this revocation.
