

District, the Wakefield Coroner's District, the Halifax Coroner's District, the Craven Coroner's District, the Kirby Malzeard Coroner's District, and (in the North Riding of the said county) the Northern Coroner's District, the Flaxton Coroner's District, the Pickering Coroner's District, and (in the East Riding of the said county) the East Riding Coroner's District, the Escrick Coroner's District, and the Bubwith Coroner's District, which said districts respectively comprised the places set forth in the Schedule to the said Order in Council.

And whereas a petition bearing date the thirtieth day of July one thousand nine hundred was presented to Her late Majesty Queen Victoria by the County Council of the East Riding of Yorkshire whereby after reciting that by a deed of surrender dated the twenty-third day of February one thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England as Lords of the Manor of Howden in the East Riding of the said county and as such entitled to exercise the franchise annexed to the said manor of appointing the Coroner for the district comprised within the said manor and the liberty of the town of Howden thereby granted, surrendered and released to Her late Majesty Her heirs and successors the power, right or franchise of appointing a Coroner for the district comprising the aforesaid manor and liberty to the intent that the said power, right or franchise might thenceforth be extinguished and cease, and that the Coroner for the said district might thenceforth be appointed by the Local Authority who by the Statute had power to appoint a Coroner having jurisdiction within the said district, and after further reciting that the Coroner for the Bubwith District had died on the sixth day of January one thousand nine hundred the petitioners prayed, for the purposes of the several Acts of Parliament therein referred to, that from and after the first day of April one thousand nine hundred and one such parts of the East Riding of the county of York as were not excepted by the first hereinbefore mentioned Act should be divided into three districts to be called respectively "The East Riding Coroner's District" "The Howden shire Coroner's District" and "The York Coroner's District."

And whereas on the twenty-ninth day of October one thousand nine hundred the said petition was amended by the substitution of "The Escrick Coroner's District" for "The York Coroner's District," and by certain amendments in the Schedule to the said original petition, and the said petition as amended was duly presented to Her late Majesty.

And whereas the said petitions with a description of the said proposed districts and of the boundaries thereof with the reasons upon which the petitions were founded were duly certified to Her late Majesty.

And whereas all the provisions of the hereinbefore first-recited Act in that behalf have been complied with.

And whereas the Coroners for the said County have not presented any petition to Her late Majesty.

And whereas Her Majesty Queen Victoria departed this life on the twenty-second day of January one thousand nine hundred and one.

And whereas His Majesty King Edward the VII has with the advice of His Privy Council taken into consideration the said petitions, and is minded to make such alteration and division as aforesaid.

Now, therefore His Majesty in Council by and

with the advice of His Privy Council is pleased to order, direct and declare, as it is hereby ordered, directed and declared, that from and after the first day of April one thousand nine hundred and one:—

1. The East Riding of Yorkshire shall be divided for Coroners purposes and for the purposes of the said first-recited Act.

2. The said three districts shall be named respectively—

The East Riding Coroner's District, the Howdenshire Coroner's District, and the Escrick Coroner's District, and the said districts shall respectively comprise the places set forth in the Schedule hereto.

3. This Order shall be published in the London Gazette.
