ORDER of the Local Government Board :
Suspension in part of General Consolidated
Order: Medical Officers' Fees :—
Swansea Union.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Swansea
Union ;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by a General Order of the Poor
Law Commissioners bearing date the twenty-fourth
day of July, one thousand eight hundred and
forty-seven, which is in force in the Swansea
Union, certain rules and regulations were made
relating to the administration of relief to the poor ;

And whereas by an Order dated the twenty-
second day of December, one thousand eight
hundred and seventy-seven, issued by Us, the
Local Government Board, the provisions of the
above-cited Order were, except as therein men-
tioned, made applicable to the Cottage Homes for
children belonging to the said Union ;

And whereas by Articles 177 to 183 (inclusive)
of the first above-cited Order provision was made
for the payment of special fees to Medical Officers
in certain cases, and it is expedient to suspend, as
hereinafter mentioned, the operation of the said
Articles as regards the Medical Officer and Assistant
Medical Officer for the Workhouse of the Union,
and the Medical Officers for the Cottage Homes
and for the No. 1 District and the No. 7 District
of the Union :

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers
given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, We
hereby suspend the operation, until We by Order
shall otherwise direct, of Articles 177 to 183
(inclusive) of the first above-cited Order with
respect to the Medical Officer and Assistant
Medical Officer for the time being for the Work-
house, and the Medical Officers for the time
being for the Cottage Homes, the No. 1 District,
and the No. 7 District of the said Union.

LIGHT RAILWAYS ACT, 1896.

COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX LIGHT RAILWAYS ORDER.

THE Light Railway Commissioners have sub-
mitted to the Board of Trade, for confirmation
