SHORES OR BANKS OF THE SEA AND OF THE RIVER TEIGN AT TEIGN-MOUTH.

REMOVAL OF MATERIALS PROBIBITED.

WHEREAS the Board of Trade, acting in pursuance of the Harbours Act, 1814, as amended by the Harbours Transfer Act, 1862, find it necessary for the protection of the Port of Teignmouth to prohibit the taking or removing of any shingle or ballast from the shores or banks of the sea and of the River Teign, between Teignmouth Pier and the outfall of the Thame Brook in the estuary of the River Teign, being within the said port.

Now the Board of Trade do hereby, by this Order, prohibit the taking or removing of any shingle or ballast from the shores or banks of the sea and of the River Teign, between the points above mentioned.

The Order dated 4th May, 1899, is hereby revoked.
