

or power, and any materials, products, matters, or things arising or used in the process of producing, generating, or transforming such energy or power, and accumulators, storage, motors, fittings, lamps, meters, and apparatus, and to exercise such powers and do such work and supply such materials as may be necessary or convenient for the production, storage, regulation, transforming, transmitting, measurement, distribution, and supply of electric energy or of power, or for providing and working material for that purpose, or for fitting up and repairing such articles, matters, and things as aforesaid, and to make charges therefor, or otherwise carrying on the undertaking of the Company.

To empower the Company to acquire, compulsorily or by agreement, easements or rights for the purpose of erecting, laying down and maintaining, and from time to time enlarging, repairing, renewing, and inspecting electric lines, with all necessary cables, pipes, tubes, boxes, posts, protective works and apparatus in, under, or over the lands, roads, railway, and property in the parish or township of Lydney, and rural district of Lydney, and the said parish of Hinton (Tything) in the rural district of Thornbury, and the bed, foreshore, and channel of the River Severn hereinafter described (that is to say):—

(A) The road numbered on the Ordnance Map (scale $\frac{1}{25000}$) 460a, in the said parish or township of Lydney, from the main road leading from the village of Purton, in the said parish, to the town of Lydney, to and along the road leading from the said road numbered 460a to the Severn Bridge station on the Great Western and Midland Railway Companies' Severn and Wye and Severn Bridge Railway and along the said railway to and across the Severn Bridge and thence along the said railway (1) to and along the branch of that railway leading to the Sharpness Docks, to the point where such branch enters the property of the Sharpness New Docks and Gloucester and Birmingham Navigation Company, and (2) to and then along the roadway numbered on the said Ordnance Map 163a, in the said parish of Hinton (Tything) and the road leading in a south-easterly and easterly direction from the southern end of the said road numbered 163a, as aforesaid, through the properties numbered in the said parish 164, 187, 190, and 191, on the said Ordnance Map, to the main road leading from Brook End to the hamlet of Purton, in the said parish of Hinton (Tything).

(B) The lauds and the bed, foreshore, and channel of the River Severn and the Gloucester and Berkeley Ship Canal and Towing Path of the Sharpness New Docks and Gloucester and Birmingham Navigation Company, at, under, and adjoining the said Severn and Wye and Severn Bridge Railway and the Severn Bridge, and the bed, foreshore, and channel of the said river lying between the said bridge and the point at which the Lanes Brook enters the River Severn, in the parish or township of Lydney aforesaid.

(C) The property numbered in the said parish of Hinton (Tything) 148 on the said Ordnance Map, from a point in the said main road leading from Brookend to the hamlet of Purton, opposite or nearly opposite Hinton Farm, to the said Severn and Wye and Severn Bridge Railway.

And to empower the Company to erect, lay down, maintain, and from time to time enlarge, repair, renew, and inspect electric lines, with all

necessary cables, pipes, tubes, boxes, posts, protective works, and other apparatus in, under, or over the said lands, roads, railway (including the Severn Bridge) and property, and the bed, foreshore, and channel of the said river and the said canal and towing path, and to open and break up the same, and to exercise in regard thereto any of the powers hereinafter mentioned with regard to roads, and the erecting or laying down of wires, pipes, and other apparatus, and if, and so far as may be necessary, to enable the Company to purchase compulsorily, or by agreement, any portions of such lands, roads, railways, bed, foreshore, and channel, and property, as may be required for such purposes.

To empower the Company, on the lands hereinafter described and elsewhere within the unions and parts of unions, townships, parishes and places hereinbefore mentioned, or any part or parts thereof, to lay down, erect, set up, maintain, renew, or remove, either above or underground, pipes, tubes, wires, casings, troughs, inspection boxes, posts, apparatus and other works, matters and things, including pipes for conveying water and any materials, matters, or things used in, or resulting from, their operations to or from their works, and to open, break up and interfere with streets, roads, public places, ways, footpaths, railways, tramways, rivers, bridges, culverts, sewers, drains, pipes, telegraphic or pneumatic tubes, wires and apparatus, and, for those purposes, or any of them, to exercise, within such limits, the powers, or some of the powers of the Gasworks Clauses Act, 1847, and the Water Works Clauses Act 1847, whether with or without modification or amendment.

To authorise the Company to take, collect, and recover rates, rents, and charges for the supply of electric energy or of power, and the use of any machines, lamps, meters, motors, transformers, fittings, or apparatus connected therewith within the limits aforesaid, and to provide for regulating the method of charging for electric energy or of power supplied therein, and the dividends to be paid and the profits to be made by the Company.

To make special provision with respect to the obligations of the Company to afford a supply of electric energy, and the terms and conditions on which such supply will be afforded, and the exercise of all or any of the powers aforesaid affecting streets and roads, and the control and regulation of the operations of the Company.

To authorise the Company to abstract and utilise for condensing and other purposes of their undertaking the waters of the Stroud Water Navigation which flows into the Gloucester and Berkeley Canal and the River Severn, and to prescribe and provide for the settlement of the terms and conditions upon which water may be so abstracted and used by the Company, and to enable the Company on the one hand, and the Company of Proprietors of the Stroud Water Navigation on the other hand, from time to time to enter into and carry into effect agreements with respect thereto.

To authorise the Company and any local authority, or any water, canal, or navigation company, or trustees, or any other company, body, or person, to enter into and carry into effect agreements with respect to all or any of the following matters (that is to say):—

The supply by the Company (whether within or beyond the limits of supply of the Company as hereinbefore defined) to such local authority, company, trustees, body, or person, of electric energy, or of power, plant, or fittings.
