Plymouth, June 28. He 25th instant put into this Port five ships from the Eastwards, all of them outwards bound, and one small Vessel from France, bound with her Lading of Salt, B andy, and Vinegar for Ircland. The 26th a ship of London fraught with Tobacco from Virginia, sailed hence for Rotterdam, and this day arrived a ship lately built in Mem England, laden with Tobacco and Sugars for London.

of Milan.

will be taken into confideration.

Venice, June 23. We have not lately had any fresh intelligence from the Levant, and consequently, no farther confirmation as yet of the success of our Admi al against the Turkith Fleet. Our Letters by the way of Legorn front Candia, only inform us, that our Captain General Morosi-, ni was with the gross of the Armata, cruifing up and down befire Ganea; and the Proveditor Extraordinary, Seighior More, with a squadron of the lighter ships plying fatther out at sea, using al possble diligence to prevent the Ene my in their intentions of recruiting their decayed 'trmy', but that they had anvile, that about 50 of the Turks Gallies were put to scaf om Conflantineple with a confictable number of other ships, laten with Soldfers and Pro-visions. They tell us also, that Cavilier Mercute with three Privateers of Maitha having put into the Isle of Mile to refit, were let upon there by the Caprain Balls and leveral Gallies under his command, who landed about 60-0, Turks, and began with much violence to allault the Ihips on every file, but they were received with furtr valout, that the Bnemy was forced in ome diffrer to quit their de-Ligh with the loss of roof of their number, and many wounded; at their terrear, they mer with a florid, which somewhat endamiged them, but are since put into Argensiere to refit.

The Siege is still continued, but carried on with much coolness at present, by reason of the small numbers of the semaining Army and the great wants they find of Necelfaries; which much encourages the belieged to make frequent Sallies, engaging them even in their own Works, and bringing off leve al heads upon their Pikes, but the Visier being much concerned at several affronts lately received, was resolved to make some considerable attempt upon the Town; and had in o der thereunto fent for 6000 Sacks f om Canca, which were to be filled with Earth and other materials, to be thrown into the Trenches to make a passage for his men, and if possible to make hims if Master of some new Post.

A Vessel from Smirna informs us that 14 of our thips parled lately in view of Cerigo, la en with Men and Ammunition for the relief of Candia, and were to be followed by as many more, which were taking in their Lading

at Zanie.

A Courrier Extraordinary arriving here I om France, informs us that His Most Christian Majesty has been pleased to make a Present to this Republick of 100 thousand Crowns in money for the defence of Candia; and has gin ven liberty for the raising of Forces within his Dominions for the f.me Service.
