- (1) Last port of call infected with plague.
- (2) The sanitary observation lasts ten entire days, counting from the date of departure from the last infected port, for ships which have finished their voyage entirely free from infection; or from the date of their arrival in the Kingdom for ships which at the date of leaving, or during the voyage, have had cases of plague on board, under conditions indicated in Article 2 of the Maritime Sanitary Ordinance of the 23rd February, 1902, No. 5.
- (3) Article 50 of the Law of 22nd December, 1888, No. 5849 (series 3A):—
“Whoever contravenes the orders published by the competent authorities with the object of preventing the introduction or diffusion of an infectious disease, is punished by a pecuniary fine not exceeding lire 500, and by imprisonment of from one to six months.
