COUNTY BOROUGH OF DUDLEY.

BYE-LAWS AND REGULATIONS made by the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the County Borough of Dudley acting by the Council as the Local Authority, under Section 46 of the Tramways Act, 1870.

With respect to the rate of speed to be observed in travelling. The distances at which carriages using the transvay shall be allowed to follow one after the other. The stopping of carriages using the tramway. The traffic on the roads in which tramways are laid.

Interpretation of Terms.

1. For the purpose of these Bye-laws and Regulations, the following words and expressions shall have the meanings hereinafter respectively assigned to them, that is to say :—

The term "Borough" means the County Borough of Dudley.

The term "The Council" means the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the County Borough of Dudley, acting by the Council.

The term "Car" shall mean any engine, machine, car, trailing car, carriage, or conveyance, using any tramways laid down within the said borough, whether moved by steam, air, gas, electricity, or any other motive power.

The term "Conductor" shall mean the person who collects passengers' fares, and who attends upon passengers when upon a tram car, or has the charge, management, or control of a tram car.

The term "Driver" shall mean the driver or other person having the charge, management, or control of the motive power of any tram or engine.

The term "Person" shall include any body of persons, whether corporate or unincorporate.

The term "Tramway" means any tramway laid down within the said borough.

The term "Vehicle" shall include a carriage, omnibus, waggonette, brake, cab, car, cart, dray, waggon, motor car, locomotive, and conveyance of whatever description.

2. Subject to Bye-law 3 the driver of every car shall cause the same to be driven at a speed of not less than 4 miles an hour on the average, and not exceeding 8 miles an hour.

3. The driver of every car shall drive the same at a speed not exceeding the following rates :---

In descending Castle Hill, Dudley, six miles an hour.
