The Civil Service Commissioners, with the consent of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, and in pursuance of the Order in Council of the 29th March, 1879, as amended by Clause 21 of the Order in Council of the 29th November, 1898, hereby give notice that persons who may have been actually appointed to the established situation of Storeholder in the Naval Ordnance Store Department of the Admiralty prior to the 3rd March, 1902, without certificates of qualification from the Civil Service Commissioners, shall be exempt from the payment of fees in respect of the issue of certificates of qualification for such situation.
