

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
AGRICULTURE.

(DATED 1ST JANUARY 1903.)

(SWINE-FEVER INFECTED AREA.)

The Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :

Declaration of Swine-Fever Infected Area.

1. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an area infected with swine-fever for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Infected Areas) Order of 1902.

Commencement.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the seventh day of January, one thousand nine hundred and three.

In witness whereof the Board of Agriculture have hereunto set their Official Seal this first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and three.

SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising the petty sessional division of Wisbech, and the borough of Wisbech, in the administrative county of the Isle of Ely ; and also comprising the parishes of West Welney, Welney, Upwell, Outwell, Emneth, Walsoken, West Walton, Wiggenhall St. Mary Magdalen, and any detached parts of the parishes of Clenchwarton, Terrington St. Clement, Terrington St. John, Tilney-cum-Islington, Tilney St. Lawrence, Tilney All Saints, Walpole St. Andrew, Walpole St. Peter, West Walton, and Wiggenhall St. Mary, which lie to the south of the southern boundaries of the main parishes of Walpole St. Peter, Terrington St. John, Tilney St. Lawrence, Tilney-cum-Islington, Wiggenhall St. German, and Wiggenhall St. Peter, in the administrative county of Norfolk.
