nd the person moving or conveying the pig, and he consignee or other person receiving or keeping, knowing it to have been moved in contravention is aforesaid, and the occupier of the place from thich the pig is moved, shall, each according to nd in respect of his own acts and defaults, be seemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases f Animals Act, 1894.

(2.) If any person with a view to unlawfully evade or defeat the operation of this Order allows a pig to stray, he shall be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.
