herein shall be deemed to invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the Order hereby revoked before the date of this revocation, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the Order hereby revoked before the date of this revocation.

SOUTHAMPTON FOREIGN ANIMALS WHARF
ORDER OF 1903.

The Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby define the following part of the Port of Southampton as a foreign animals wharf :

All that space at the Southampton Docks, in the county borough of Southampton, coloured pink on the plan sealed by the Board of Agriculture for the purposes of this Order and deposited at the office of the Board of Agriculture.

This Order may be cited as the SOUTHAMPTON FOREIGN ANIMALS WHARF ORDER OF 1903.
