KING'S LYNN AND DISTRICT (SWINE-FEVER) PROHIBITION OF MOVEMENT REVOCATION ORDER OF 1903.

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The Order described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby from and after the commencement of this Order revoked: Provided that such revocation shall not invalidate or make unlawful

anything done under the Order hereby revoked before the commencement of this Order, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the Order hereby revoked before the commencement of this Order.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-seventh day of November, nineteen hundred and three.

3. This Order may be cited as the KING'S LYNN AND DISTRICT (SWINE-FEVER) PROHIBITION OF MOVEMENT REVOCATION ORDER OF 1903.
