

"THE SECOND SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be dissevered from the said new parish of Saint Paul Thornton Heath and to be annexed to the new parish of All Saints Norwood aforesaid being:—

"All that portion of the said new parish of Saint Paul Thornton Heath which is bounded upon the east partly by the new parish of Saint John the Evangelist Upper Norwood in the county and diocese aforesaid and partly by the new parish of All Saints Norwood aforesaid upon the north-east and upon the north-west by the last-named new parish (including the above described portion thereof) and upon the remaining side that is to say upon the south-west by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of All Saints Norwood from the new parish of Saint Paul Thornton Heath aforesaid at the junction of Sparoad aforesaid with Penrith-road and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of thirteen chains or thereabouts to its junction with Burlington-road and extending thence south-westward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of three chains or thereabouts to its junction with Speke-road and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of seven chains and a half or thereabouts to its junction with Livingstone-road and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of eleven yards or thereabouts to its junction with Hythe-road and extending thence first south-eastward then eastward then again south-eastward then southward and then again south-eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of nineteen chains and a half or thereabouts to its junction with Grange-road upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint Paul Thornton Heath from the new parish of Saint John the Evangelist Upper Norwood aforesaid.

"THE THIRD SCHEDULE.

"The territory to be dissevered from the said new parish of Saint Paul Thornton Heath and to be annexed to the new parish of Saint John the Evangelist Upper Norwood aforesaid being:—

"All that portion of the said new parish of Saint Paul Thornton Heath which is bounded upon the east by the said new parish of Saint John the Evangelist Upper Norwood and upon the remaining sides that is to say upon the south-west upon the north-west and upon the north by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint John the Evangelist Upper Norwood from the new parish of Saint Paul Thornton Heath aforesaid at the centre of the bridge which carries Whitehorse-road over the Croydon and Balham line of the London Brighton and South Coast Railway and extending thence north-westward along the middle of the said line of railway for a distance of seventeen chains or thereabouts to a point at the middle of the foot bridge which carries over the said line of railway the footway leading from Bensham Manor-road to Elm-road and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of the said footway for a distance of one chain or thereabouts to its junction with Elm-road aforesaid and extending thence north-westward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of eleven yards or thereabouts to its junction with Gillett-road and extending thence north-eastward to and along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of eleven chains and a half or thereabouts to its junction with High-street and extending thence westward along the middle of the last-named street for a distance of one

chain or thereabouts to its junction with the road called The Drive and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of nine chains or thereabouts to its north-eastern end on the wall or fence forming the south-western boundary of the premises attached to the Lambeth Water Works Reservoir and extending thence eastward and in a direct line across the said premises and reservoir for a distance of five chains and a quarter or thereabouts to a point at the junction of Grange-road with Ross-road upon the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint Paul Thornton Heath from the new parish of Saint John the Evangelist Upper Norwood aforesaid."

And whereas drafts of the said scheme or representation have been transmitted to the patrons and to the Incumbents of the cures affected by the arrangements which are contemplated by such scheme or representation and such patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent thereto.

And whereas the said scheme or representation has been approved by His Majesty in Council: now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said scheme or representation, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts; and His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said diocese of Canterbury.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have in pursuance of the Act of the thirty-third and thirty-fourth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter thirty-nine, and of the Acts therein mentioned, that is to say the Act of the third and fourth years of Her said late Majesty chapter one hundred and thirteen, the Act of the fourth and fifth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter thirty-nine, and the Act of the thirty-first and thirty-second years of Her said late Majesty chapter one hundred and fourteen duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council a scheme bearing date the seventeenth day of December, in the year one thousand nine hundred and three, in the words following, that is to say:—
