

middle, and surmounted by a white lantern and gallery, erected in a position 40 yards N. 22° W. from the former High Light tower, the light power being 164,000 candles.

From the same tower a subsidiary fixed light is exhibited at an elevation of 55 feet above high water, visible in clear weather from a distance of 13 miles, and showing the following sectors, viz.:—Red (light power 12,800 candles) from N. 70° E. to N. 85° E.; green (light power 40,700 candles) from N. 85° E., through east, to S. 74° E.; red (light power 65,000 candles) from S. 37° W. to S. 57° W., and obscured in other directions.

2. Low light is unchanged in character, being white flashing every five seconds, thus:—Flash, about two seconds; eclipse, about three seconds; but is now elevated 38 feet above high water, and visible in clear weather from a distance of 11 miles from the bearing of S. 28° W., through west and north, to S. 59° E. It is shown from a red cylindrical tower, 40 feet high, above the new fog signal house, which is also red, erected at a distance of 485 yards S. 67° E. from the new High Light tower, its light power being of 11,100 candles.

3. The fog siren, which is established under the Low Light, will give during thick or foggy weather two blasts in quick succession every two minutes, thus:—High note, three and a quarter seconds; silent interval, two and a half seconds; low note, three and a quarter seconds; silent interval, one hundred and eleven seconds.

The old light towers and fog signal house will be removed as soon as possible.

Approximate position, High Light, latitude 50° 54' N., longitude 0° 58' E.

Messauri (Messauri) Islands—Reef Northward of.

The Netherlands Government has given notice, dated 25th March, 1904, of the existence of a reef about 4 miles long in a northerly and southerly direction, and 3 miles broad, in a position about 9 miles to the northward of Messauri Islands. A depth of 8 fathoms was obtained on this reef, but there are apparently patches with less water over them.

From it Swandei Island bears N. 26° E., distant 22 miles, and the south-east extreme of Misnum (Meosnum) N. 56° E.

Approximate position, lat. 1° 50' S., long. 134° 48' E.
