WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the third and fourth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and

thirteen, of the Act of the fourth and fifth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter thirty-nine, of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter ninety-four, of the Act of the thirty-first and thirty-second years of Her said late Majesty chapter one hundred and fourteen, of the Act of the thirty-third and thirty-fourth years of Her said late Majesty chapter thirty-nine, and of the Act of the forty-eighth and forty-ninth years of Her said late Majesty chapter fifty-five, duly prepared and laid before His Majesty in Council a scheme, bearing date the nineteenth day of May, in the year one thousand nine hundred and four, in the words following, that is to say:—

“ We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the third and fourth years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter one hundred and thirteen, of the Act of the fourth and fifth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter thirty-nine, of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter ninety-four, of the Act of the thirty-first and thirty-second years of Her said late Majesty, chapter one hundred and fourteen, of the Act of the thirty-third and thirty-fourth years of Her said late Majesty chapter thirty-nine, and of the Act of the forty-eighth and forty-ninth years of Her said late Majesty, chapter fifty-five, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following scheme for providing an endowment for the archdeaconry of Lindisfarne, in the diocese of Newcastle, for disannexing the benefice (being a vicarage) of Eglington, in the county of Northumberland and in the said diocese of Newcastle, from the said archdeaconry of Lindisfarne, and for effecting a transfer of the patronage of the said benefice of Eglington.
