

supply Gas within the parish of South Hayling and the parish of North Hayling, both of which said parishes are within the district of the Rural District Council of Havant and in the county of Southampton; to supply Gas in bulk; supply Gas Fittings and Apparatus; to lay Mains and Pipes; holding and acquisition of Lands; break up Roads and Streets; levy Rates and Charges; to make Agreements with Local Authorities and others; to define Existing Capital and raise Additional Capital; Borrowing Powers; Incorporation of Acts; and other purposes.)

**N**OTICE is hereby given, that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade by the Hayling Island Gas Company Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") for a Provisional Order (hereinafter called "the Order,") pursuant to the powers of "The Gas and Waterworks Facilities Act, 1870," for the following purposes, or some of them (that is to say):—

1. To authorize and empower the Company on the piece of land hereinafter described to maintain and continue, and, from time to time, to improve, enlarge, renew, alter, pull down, re-erect, or discontinue their existing gasworks and works connected therewith; to construct, erect, make and maintain, and, from time to time, alter, enlarge, extend, renew and discontinue retorts, retort houses, gasholders, receivers, purifiers, meters, apparatus and works for the manufacture, distribution, storage, conversion, and sale of all kinds of gas, whether manufactured from coal slack or other substance or liquid, and of coke and other residual products arising in or resulting or producible from or used in the manufacture of gas, on the following lands now belonging to, or in the occupation of the Company whereon the existing gasworks of the Company are erected, namely:—

A piece of land situate in Station Road (formerly known as Sinah Lane), in the parish of South Hayling, in the county of Southampton, containing by admeasurement forty poles or thereabouts, bounded on the north by land belonging or reputed to belong to George Staunton Lynch Staunton, on the south by the said Station Road, on the east by land belonging or reputed to belong to Harry Frederick Trigg and Frederick Leng, Trustees under the Will of the late Harry Richard Trigg, and on the west by land belonging or reputed to belong to Samuel Barnet.

2. To enable the Company to purchase, take on lease, or acquire by agreement and hold for the general purposes of this Undertaking other than the manufacture and storage of gas, such other lands, easements and property as may hereafter be required, and to maintain, construct, alter, enlarge, renew, or discontinue houses, offices, buildings, and other works connected with the Undertaking.

3. To authorize the Company in and upon the land above described, or some part or parts thereof, to manufacture, store, and distribute gas, oil, and residual products arising from the manufacture of gas and matters producible therefrom, or used in the manufacture of gas, and to supply and sell gas for public and private purposes within the area or limits following, or any part or parts thereof (hereinafter called "the limits of supply"): the parishes of South Hayling and North Hayling in the rural district of Havant in the county of Southampton, and on the before-mentioned lands and elsewhere, to sell and dispose of coal, tar, coke, pitch, asphaltum, ammoniacal liquor, oil, and sulphate of ammonia, and all other residual and manufactured products,

and things arising from the manufacture of gas.

4. To authorize the Company, so far as may be necessary or desirable for any of the purposes of their Undertaking, and so as to enable them to furnish and supply gas within the area or limits of supply, to open and break up, cross, alter, divert, and interfere with the several streets (whether dedicated to the public use or not), roads, highways, lanes, bridges, and other public and private passages and places, canals, towing-paths, railways and tramways, within the said area or limits, and remove, divert, or alter any sewers, drains, pipes, and telegraphic, telephonic and electric posts, conductors, wires, and apparatus in, over or under the same, and to lay down, extend, repair, and maintain any mains, service pipes, valves, syphons, and other works connected with or incidental to the supply of gas.

5. To enable the Company to manufacture, purchase, or hire, and supply gas meters, fittings, gas and cooking stoves, and other apparatus, and also to manufacture, purchase, let or deal in and contract for doing work in connection with fittings, meters, pipes, burners, chandeliers, cooking and other stoves, engines, machines for the production of motive power for domestic, agricultural, manufacturing, and other purposes by means of gas heating apparatus, and all other articles, apparatus and things in any way connected with gas or necessary for, or incidental to, any of the purposes for which gas is applicable.

6. To enable the Company to manufacture produce, obtain and supply Mond or other producer gas, and the means of obtaining artificial light or power of any kind, and to acquire, hold, use and exercise patent and other rights and licences in relation to the manufacture, storage, supply, utilization, or distribution of gas and products, matters and things obtainable in or arising from such manufacture or from the materials used therein.

7. To authorize the Company to contract with any urban or rural district Council or other local authority, company, or persons for the supply of gas in bulk or otherwise within or beyond the area or limits beforementioned for any purposes whatsoever.

8. To levy and recover rates and charges for the supply of gas and residual products, and for the supply, hire or use of meters, fittings, engines, and other articles, apparatus and things supplied by the Company.

9. To require consumers of gas supplied by the Company to give to the Company notice in writing before connecting or disconnecting any gas meter, or before discontinuing the consumption of gas or ceasing to occupy houses, buildings or other premises supplied with gas by the Company and to make provision for the recovery of moneys due to the Company for the supply of gas or the hire or fixing of meters, pipes, and fittings or for the supply of coke and other residual products by distress or otherwise.

10. To authorize the Company to apply their existing funds to the purposes or any of the purposes of the intended Order, and to increase their share and loan capital, and to raise further money for the purposes of their Undertaking by the creation and issue of new shares or stock with or without a guarantee or preference dividend or other rights or privileges attached thereto, and if thought fit in one or more classes, and by borrowing and by the creation and issue of debenture stock, or by any or either of such means or otherwise, to define and regulate the existing capital, and generally to make such
