A PROCLAMATION.

EDWARD, R. & I.

Whereas Our Parliament stands prorogued to Tuesday, the seventeenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and five; We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, hereby issue Our Royal Proclamation, and publish and declare that the said Parliament be further prorogued to Tuesday, the fourteenth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and five; and We do hereby further, with the advice aforesaid, declare Our Royal Will and pleasure that the said Parliament shall, on the said Tuesday, the fourteenth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and five, assemble and be holden

for the despatch of divers urgent and important affairs; and the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Knights, Citizens, and Burgesses, and the Commissioners for shires and burghs, of the House of Commons, are hereby required and commanded to give their attendance accordingly at Westminster, on the said Tuesday, the fourteenth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and five.

Given at Our Court at Buckingham Palace, this twelfth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and five, and in the fourth year of Our Reign.
