#### ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 29TH JULY 1905.)

##### (SHEEP-SCAB COMPULSORY DIPPING AREA.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

The Sheep-Scab (Compulsory Dipping Areas) Order of 1905 in its application to the Compulsory Dipping Area described in the First Schedule hereto shall be modified as follows:—

- (a) Sheep may be moved from any premises in the Compulsory Dipping Area to one of the dipping-places specified in the Second Schedule to this Order if accompanied by a licence granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the District from which they are moved.
- (b) The sheep shall after being dipped at the dipping-place be moved as soon as practicable back to the premises from which they were moved for dipping.
- (c) The movement to and from the dipping place shall be supervised by an Inspector or other officer of the Local Authority.

(d) Sheep moved under a licence under this Order shall during the movement and detention at the dipping-place be as far as practicable kept separate from all other sheep.

##### FIRST SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising those parts of the administrative counties of Lancaster and the West Riding of the county of York which lie within the following boundary, excluding the roads which form part of that boundary, namely:—

Commencing at the point where the main road from Clitheroe to Chipping crosses the river Ribble, and proceeding westerly along that road over Higher Hodder Bridge, by Walker Fold to the guide-post at the junction of that road with the road to Bradley Hall, thence north-westerly and westerly following the main road aforesaid by Wood Top and Gibbon Bridge to Chipping, thence south-westerly along the road by Three Lane End and Black Hall to Collin's Hill-lane,
