The dates between which all sheep in the Compulsory Dipping Area described in the Schedule to this Order are to be treated by the owner for sheep-scab by effective dipping under Article 2 of the Sheep-Scab (Compulsory Dipping Areas) Order of 1905 are hereby fixed to be the fourteenth day of October and the eleventh day of November in every year.

An Area comprising that part of the administrative county of Merioneth which lies within the following boundary, namely:—

Commencing at a point on the south side of the mouth of the River Mawdach, thence following the course of the said river to its junction with the River Wnion, thence following the course of the River Wnion to Dolgelly Bridge, thence by the road through Dolgelly, past Tyn-y-cornel to the point where the said road meets the River Dysynni, thence following that river to the sea, and thence following the coast to the point of commencement.
