The Board of Agriculture and Fisherics, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered; as follows :

Rams entered for exhibition or sale at the Sale specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be exempt from the provisions of the Sheep-Dipping (Scotland) Order of 1905, but such rams shall not be moved out of the Dipping Area to which such Order relates, unless accompanied by a Licence granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority of the district from which they are so moved, which licence shall only be granted upon production of a veterinary certificate showing freedom from disease or a declaration signed by the owner of the sheep or his agent authorised in writing for this purpose to the effect that the rams have been dipped since the eighteenth day of June, nineteen hundred and five.

to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered; as follows: °. 11

Application of Principal Order to an Area constituted a separate Dipping Area.

(1.) The Area described in the Schedule 1.hereto shall cease to form part of the Dipping Area to which the Sheep-Dipping (Scotland) Order of 1905 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order ") as amended by the Sheep-Dipping (Scotland) Order of 1905 (No. 2) applies, and shall become a separate Dipping Area.


(2.) In the Dipping Area described in the Schedule hereto the prescribed dipping period under Article 4 of the principal Order shall be extended from the first day of September to the first day of October next, and the termination of the period during which Article 8 (Restrictions on Markets, &c., and of Movement out of Dipping Area) is in operation, shall be deferred from the first day of October next to the first day of November next.

Construction.

2. This Order shall be read as one with the principal Order, and the principal Order as modified by the Sheep-Dipping (Scotland) Order of 1905 (No. 3) shall be construed in relation to the Dipping Area described in the Schedule hereto as if it were the Dipping Area referred to in the principal Order.

Short Title.

3. This Order may be cited as the SHEEF-DIPPING (SCOTLAND) ORDER OF 1905 (No. 4).
