## ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES. (DATED 13TH SEPTEMBER 1905.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Sheep-Scab (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1905 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order), or any Order modifying the same, and the Order of the Board dated the 15th day of March, 1905, whereby such provisions are applied to the scheduled area defined by such last-mentioned Order, sheep exhibited at any of the Markets and Fairs specified in the schedule hereto may be moved therefrom to any premises in the county of Radnor outside the said scheduled area, subject to and in accordance with the provisions of this Order, and, if so moved, shall so far as regards such movement be exempt from the provisions of the Principal Order with respect to detention and isolation after arrival at destination.

2. The sheep shall be accompanied by a licence authorising such movement granted by an Inspector of the Local Authority for the county of Brecon, which licence shall only be granted 'Order).

upon production of (a) the certificate of a Veterinary Inspector of the said Local Authority, appointed by them for the purpose, to the effect that to the best of his knowledge and belief all the sheep exhibited at the Market or Fair from which the sheep are to be moved are free from sheep-scab and that he has personally examined each of the sheep to be moved and found it to be free fron sheep-scab; and (b) a declaration, signed by the person who is, at the time of the granting of the licence, the owner of the sheep, or by his agent authorised in writing for this purpose, to the effect that the sheep have within the period of twenty-four hours next before the making of the declaration been brought to be exposed for sale at the Market or Fair from the premises in the said county to which they are to be moved, and that such premises are in the occupation of such owner.

3. The said Veterinary Inspector shall be in attendance at the said Market or Fair through-

out its continuance.

4. The following Articles of the Principal Order shall apply to the movement of sheep under this Order (that is to say): Article 6 (Provisions as to Movement Licences); Article 9 (General Provisions as to Movement); Article 12 (Production of Licences; Names and Adaresses); and Article 13 (Local Authority to enforce
