

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF  
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 6TH OCTOBER 1905.)

The Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in them under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1903, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

The operation of the provisions of Part II (*Regulation of Exposure and Movement of Sheep in Compulsory Dipping Areas*) of the Sheep-Scab (Compulsory Dipping Areas) Order of 1905 shall be suspended in their application to the Compulsory Dipping Area described in the Schedule to this Order from and after the tenth day of October, nineteen hundred and five, until the fifteenth day of April, nineteen hundred and six.

In witness whereof the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries have hereunto set their Official Seal this sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and five.

## SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising those parts of the administrative counties of Durham and Cumberland which lie within the following boundary (excluding the roads which form part of that boundary), namely:—

Commencing at a point where the Darlington and Tebay Branch of the North Eastern Railway crosses the River Tees, on the boundary between the counties of Durham and York, north-west of Barnard Castle, and thence proceeding in a north-westerly direction along that boundary to the point of junction of the counties of Cumberland, Durham, and Westmorland, at Crookburn Beck, thence northerly along the boundary between the counties of Cumberland and Durham, to the point where Crookburn Beck is crossed by the main road from Alston to Middleton in Teesdale, thence north-westerly following the course of that road to the point of its junction with the main road from Garrigill to Nenthead, thence north-easterly along that road through Nenthead to the boundary between the counties of Cumberland and Northumberland at Black Hill, thence south-easterly along that boundary and easterly and north-easterly along the boundary between the counties of Durham and Northumberland to Allensford Bridge, thence southerly along the main road through Castleside to Bridge-street, Towlaw, thence easterly along that street to the Police Station, thence southerly along the main road by West Park and Helme Park to the guide-post opposite to the eastern corner of Collier Wood, thence southerly along the road to the southern corner of Cold Knot West plantation, thence south-westerly along the road to the guide-post at the junction of the four roads near the fourth milestone from Wolsingham, thence south-easterly along the road by Harperley Lodge to Fir Tree Inn, thence southerly along the main road to Witton-le-Wear Green, thence southerly

and easterly along the main road through Toft Hill to High Etherley, thence south-easterly along the main road leading to West Auckland to the point where that road is crossed by the Barnard Castle Branch of the North Eastern Railway, thence south-westerly along that railway to the point of commencement.
