19	From the Elmscleugh and Thurston Mains-road, by High Wood to junction with the road leading from Woodhall, by Birky Muir, to Thurston.
20	From Weatherly to Woodhall.
29	From the Great Post-road, near Barneyhill, towards the sea (Strand-road).
30 & 32	From the Great Post-road, near east entrance gate to Broxmouth by Wester and Meikle Pinkerton, to join the road from Eastbarns to Elmscleugh.
33	Portion of the road from Dunbar Burgh boundary at Slaughter House by Spott Village and Burnhead Smithy, extending from top of Spott Mill Brae to Burnhead Smithy.
34	Portion of the road from Halls to Pitcox, extending the whole length of Nick Brae only.
