

6. To enable the Company to provide, maintain and manage refreshment rooms at the said port of Hull, and to supply or make provision for the supply of refreshments thereat and in any buildings which may be used in connection with any service of steam or other vessels established by the Company or in which they may obtain any interest under the powers of the intended Act, and to supply or provide for the supply of refreshments on any vessels employed in any such service.

7. To empower the Company to raise, for the purposes of the intended Act, further sums of money by the creation of new shares or stock, with or without a preferential or guaranteed dividend or other rights or privileges attached thereto, and by borrowing, and by the creation of debenture stock or by any or either of those means, and to apply to the purposes of the intended Act any moneys now belonging to the Company or which they are by any existing Act or may by any other Act of the ensuing Session or any future Act be authorized to raise.

8. To vary and extinguish any existing rights or privileges which would interfere with the purposes of the intended Act and to confer other rights and privileges.

9. To incorporate, with or without modification, all or any of the provisions of the Railways Clauses Act, 1863.

10. To repeal, alter or extend, amend and enlarge, so far as may be necessary for the purposes of the intended Act, all or some of the powers or provisions of the Hull, Barnsley and West Riding Junction Railway and Dock Act, 1880, and any other Act or Acts relating to or affecting the Company or their Undertaking.

#### SLOUGH WATER.

(Additional Capital; Extension of Limits of Supply; Amendment of Acts.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Slough Waterworks Company (hereinafter called "the Company") intend to apply to the Board of Trade on or before the 23rd day of December next, under the Gas and Waterworks Facilities Act, 1870, and the Gas and Waterworks Facilities Act (1870) Amendment Act, 1873, for a Provisional Order, to be confirmed by Parliament in the ensuing Session, for the following purposes or some of them (that is to say):—

To authorize the Company to raise a further sum of money by the creation and issue of new ordinary and preference shares or stock, and by borrowing on mortgage, and by the creation and issue of debenture stock or partially by any one or more of such means.

To extend, alter and define the limits within which the Company may supply water so as to include therein the parishes of Fulmer, Hedgerley, Hedgerley Dean, such portion of the parish of Horton as lies south of and within a distance of a quarter of a mile from the Bath-road, and so

much of the parish of Burnham as lies south of the Great Western Railway, all which parishes are in the county of Buckingham and the hamlet of Poyle, in the parish of Stanwell and county of Middlesex.

To confer upon the Company and to enable them to exercise within the extended limits of supply all such powers, privileges and authorities for the supply and sale of water, including the levying of rents, rates and charges as they now have within their existing limits of supply, and to confer, vary and extinguish exemptions from and to compound for the payment of such rents, rates and charges.

To enable the Company to exercise within the extended limits of supply all such powers of executing works and acquiring by agreement and holding lands, property and easements for the purposes of their Undertaking as they now have within their existing limits of supply.

To authorize the Company from time to time for the purpose of laying down, repairing and maintaining any mains, conduits, pipes, culverts and other works, to break up and interfere with streets, roads, highways, bridges, railways, lanes and other public and private passages and places and sewers, drains, pipes and wires in, over or under the same within the extended limits of supply, and to sanction and authorize the maintenance and continuance of any such works which have been already constructed or laid down by the Company.

To amend, extend, alter or repeal, so far as may be necessary for the purposes of the intended Order, the Slough Waterworks Act, 1875, and the Slough Water Order, 1901, and any other Act or Acts or any Order or Orders relating to the Company.
