The KING Commands that the Court shall wear Mourning from Thursday next, the 1st February, for six weeks for His late Majesty The King of Denmark, K.G., father of Her Majesty Queen Alexandra.

The Ladies to wear black Dresses, white Gloves, black or white Shoes, Feathers, and Fans. Pearls, Diamonds, or plain gold or silver Ornaments.

The Gentlemen to wear Crepe Band on the Left Arm, in Uniform or Court Dress.

The Court to Change to Half Mourning on Thursday, the 1st March next.

The Ladies to wear black Dresses with coloured Ribbons, Flowers, Feathers, and Ornaments; or grey or white Dresses, with black Ribbons, Flowers, Feathers, and Ornaments.

The Gentlemen to continue the same Mourning.

And on Thursday, the 15th March, the Court to go out of Mourning.
