I hereby give notice, pursuant to the 9th and 16th sections of the Act 5 and 6 Victoria, cap. 110, intituled "An Act for better preserving the Navigation of the River Mersey," that I have received a notice from the Mersey Docks and Harbour Board of their intention to carry out works with the consents of the Lords of the Admiralty and of the Commissioners for the Conservancy of the River Mersey, under the powers of and as provided by the Mersey Docks and Harbour Act, 1857, and the Mersey Dock Acts Consolidation Act, 1858, in or adjoining to Crosby Channel, being a sea channel within the Port of Liverpeal to improve and better price Port of Liverpool, to improve and better main-tain and preserve the navigation of the port for the safety and convenience of ships frequenting the same. A copy of the notice is subjoined.

The Mersey Docks and Harbour Board hereby give notice of their intention to construct the undermentioned work or works in the estuary of the River Mersey under their powers contained in sections 54, 55, and 56 of the Mersey Docks and Harbour Act, 1857, and section 100 of the Mersey Dock Acts Consolidation Act, 1858, with the consent of the Commissioners for the Conservancy of the River Mersey, under sections 54 and 55 of the 1857 Act and of the Lords of the Admiralty under section 357 of the 1858 Act, viz. :-

A stone revetment to the height of mean low water mark, or thereabouts, of the southerly face of Taylor's Bank, in Crosby Channel, in the estuary of the River Mersey or Liverpool Bay, commencing at or near the southerly end of Formby Channel at a point situate 1,370 yards, or thereabouts, measured in a south-westerly direction from the Beach Mark on the foreshore of the Urban District of Little Crosby, known as the Crosby Beach Mark, and terminating at a point situate 5,360 yards, or thereabouts, measured in a west-wardly direction from the said Crosby Beach Mark.

The object of the work is to deepen, widen and straighten the Crosby Channel, being a sea channel within the Port of Liverpool, with a view to improving, better maintaining and preserving the navigation of the Port for the safety and convenience of ships frequenting the same.

The works will, with the consents aforesaid, be commenced in or after one month from this date. They will not exclude, impede or interrupt the tidal or other waters of the River Mersey.

Plans and sections of the proposed works have been deposited at the Mersey Conservancy Office, 66, Victoria-street, London, S.W., and with the Hydrographer to the Admiralty, at the Admiralty, London, S.W.
