

last known place of abode or business or sent through the post in a letter addressed to him there, and a notice or other document purporting to be signed by the clerk of a Local Authority shall be *prima facie* evidence that it was signed by him and duly authorised by the Local Authority.

Commencement.

9. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-eighth day of October, nineteen hundred and seven.

Short Title.

10. This Order may be cited as the DERBY-SHIRE, LEICESTERSHIRE AND NOTTINGHAMSHIRE (GOOSEBERRY MILDEW) ORDER OF 1907.
