- (2.) The following conditions shall apply to such movement:
  - (i.) The Licence shall be granted by the Clerk to the Verderers of the New Forest or an Agister authorised to act in this behalf by the said Clerk;
  - (ii.) The swine shall before being moved from the exhibition be marked by and at the expense of the owner by the painting, with an indelible composition of red colour, of a broad line down the back and another broad line across the loins of each of the swine, thus +, each line being not less than nine inches long;
  - (iii.) The Licence shall be in force for not more than four days inclusive of the day of issue;
  - (iv.) The swine shall be moved by the nearest available route and without unnecessary delay, and shall during the movement, as far as is practicable, be kept separate from all other swine not being moved under this Order;
  - (v.) The Licence shall forthwith after completion of the movement be delivered up at, or sent by post to, the nearest Police Station by the person in charge of the swine at the time of completing the said movement;
  - (vi.) The swine shall be detained at the bacon factory or slaughter-house until they are slaughtered;
  - (vii.) A copy of the Licence shall be sent by the person granting the same to the Local

Authority of the District wherein the place of destination of the swine is situate.

General Provisions as to Movement.

3. Swine moved from the said exhibition with a Licence under this Order shall not be subject to any restriction on movement of swine imposed by Order of the Board or by any Regulation of a Local Authority made under any such Order.
