1. From and after the commencement of this Order the provisions of the Swine-Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1908 shall apply to the Scheduled Area described in the First Schedule hereto. Provided that the provisions of that Order relating to an Infected Area shall not apply to any part of the Scheduled Area, unless such part is for the time being declared by Order of the Board to be, or form part of, a Swine-Fever Infected Area.

Revocation.

2. The Orders described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and eight.
